This year, we have four \$500.00 scholarship winners, graduating from four different high schools in Ulster and Duchess, for the two types of scholarships offered by the

Kingston Männerchor and Damenchor:

- 1. **Desmond Mulready** from Kingston High School won a Scholarship in Choral Singing and Individual Vocal Performance. He has excelled in Choir and Voice at Kingston High School and is interested in European culture(s). Last summer, he visited Salzburg and Vienna and was astonished at how much classical music and opera is ingrained in society there. Seeing a performance of Mozart's Zauberflöte inspired him to include "Der Vogelfänger" in his audition repertoire. He plans to study vocal performance in college and further explore the German language. He dreams of performing in Viennna some day, maybe even as Papageno. Desmond's vocal repertoire includes songs in English, Italian, German, and Latin.
- 2. **Grace E. Hopf** from Saugerties High School also won a Scholarship in Choral Singing and Individual Performance. She wants to become a Music Teacher and has already been accepted by 4 Schools of Music. Grace became interested in European culture by learning to sing in Italian, French, German, and Spanish, which she loved so much that she preferred singing in foreign languages to performing in English. Visiting Barcelona with her family made her fall in love with Europe: the different people, food, and music. This experience reinforced her decision to study abroad in her junior year in college. She intends to pursue a degree in Music Education to motivate other students to find their passion for music.
- 3. **Milo Turba** from Onteora High School won a scholarship in Choral Singing and Individual Performance also. As a member of the Onteora High School Chorus, Milo sang solos, and re-auditioned for All County Chorus. He joined afterschool clubs like Sounds of Jazz and Chamber Chorus. Last year, he was on the big stage in the Musical "School of Rock." In the fall, he will start his college education in Greece in a program associated with the University of Northeastern. He will minor in Music, taking many cultural music courses dealing with Greek and other European music. He wants to experience as much of the music culture in Europe as possible, whether listening to live music in a restaurant or going to Germany to hear a concert at the famous Berlin Philharmonic.
- 4. **Lotta Grannis Pflaum** from Red Hook HS won a scholarship in Excellence in German Language and Music. Lotta has German heritage and grew up listening to and singing German music. She has always enjoyed singing, particularly in foreign languages. She has a trinational background: US, German, and Ethiopian., and has been an exchange student in Spain and Germany because of her interest in foreign languages and international culture. At NYSSM last May, she was asked to join both All State and Area All State Choruses. She will be studying at Cornell University in the fall, continuing with German and singing, perhaps even in the college choir.
